MODERN DAY SLAVERY & HUMAN TRAFFICKING POLICY

This statement has been published in accordance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015. It addresses the steps taken by National Flexible Ltd. to prevent modern slavery in its business and supply chain. As such, this statement provides transparency for customers and shareholders, so they continue to have confidence in the products and services they buy and support.

Modern slavery is a global issue that unfortunately continues to grow. Alongside this growth however, there has also been an increase in understanding and acknowledgment of the devastating impact that forced labour and human trafficking has on individuals, communities and society. We are committed to improving our practices to combat slavery and human trafficking and for this reason; National Flexible Ltd. has a zero-tolerance approach to modern slavery in any form.

National Flexible Ltd. is a convertor and supplier of plain and speciality films and relies upon a complex global supply chain encompassing raw materials, goods and services. Our suppliers are a key element of our success and we consider it essential that they understand and are able to meet our long-term needs.

Incorporated into our supplier approval process is a review of regulatory compliance and ethical controls undertaken. Imported materials from sources outside the EU are potentially higher risk and can be subject to enhanced background checks including supplier reputation and sanctions. The level of management control required for these sources will be continually monitored.

As part of our commitment we also subscribe to the Supplier Ethical Data Exchange (SEDEX), a not for profit membership organisation dedicated to driving improvements in responsible and ethical business practices in global supply chains.

This policy statement represents the commitment of National Flexible Limited and shall be reviewed annually.
